Most importantly, while creating on the pages ahead, I want you to have FUN.

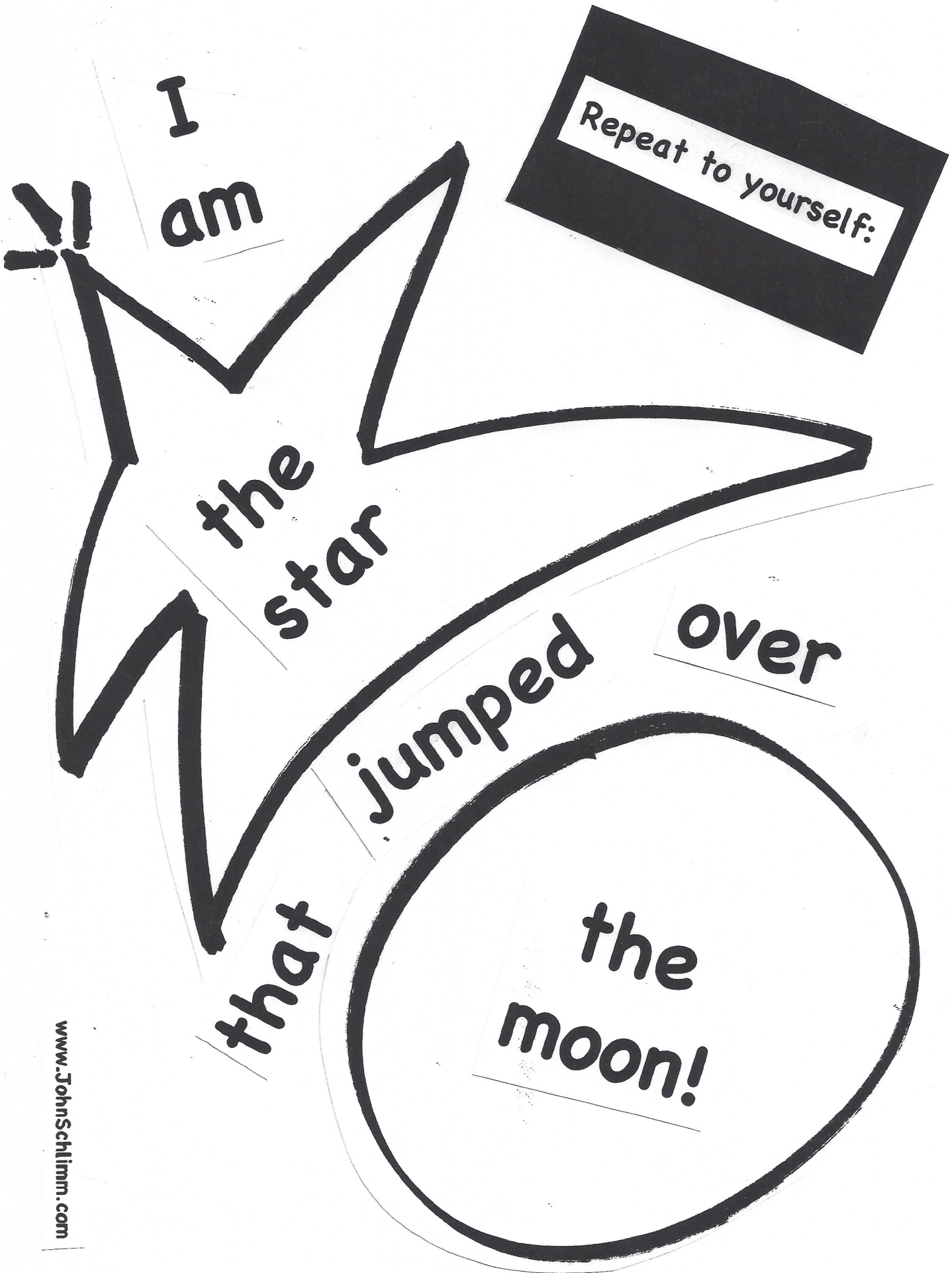

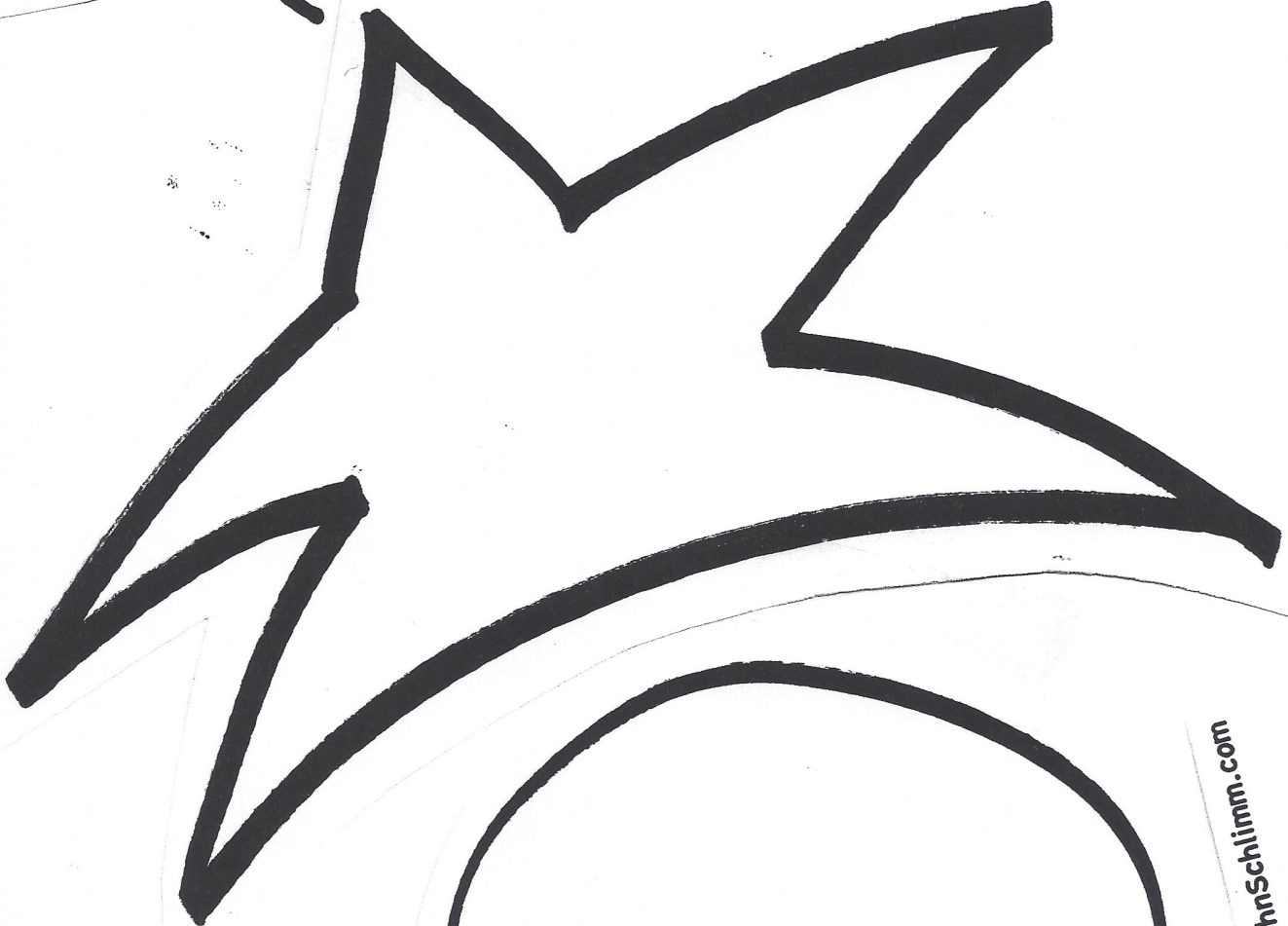

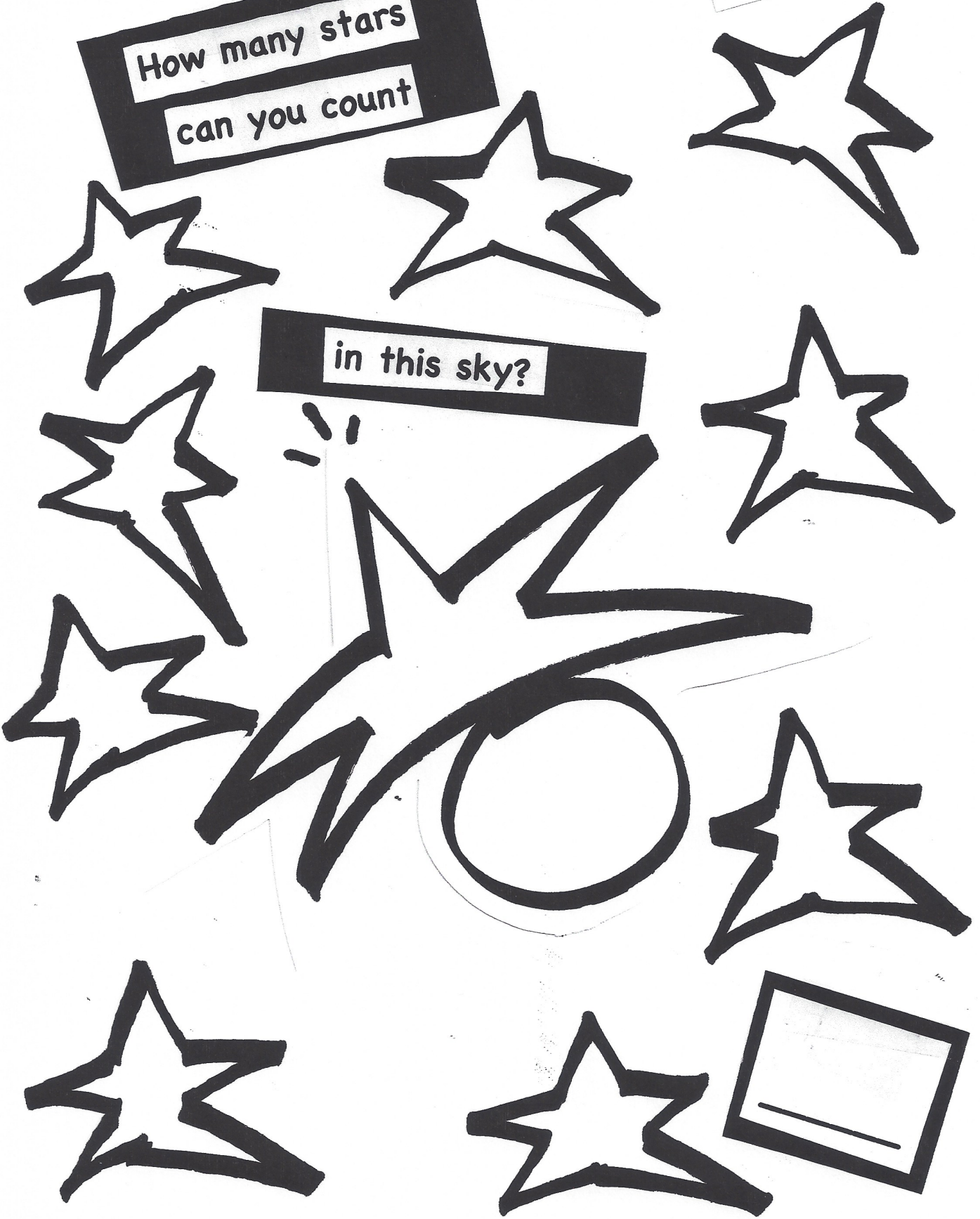

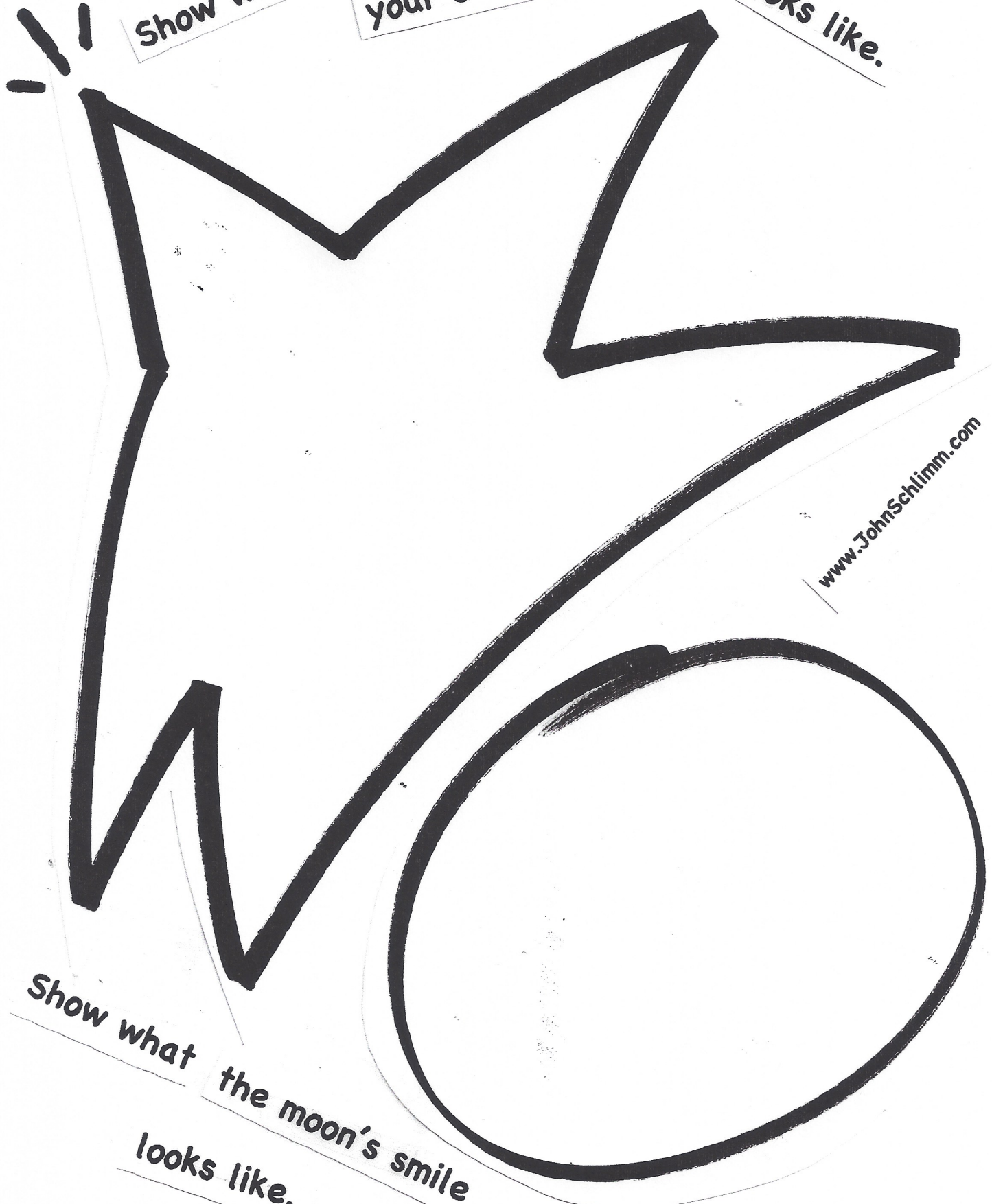
